



the right, turn right and walk straight down the fence line between the two fields – there are likely to be animals in the fields, so make sure you leave the gates as you found them and keep dogs on leads. After a couple of fields, the path passes some stables on the left and then crosses Bilton Beck on the footbridge.

- 4) Once over the bridge, turn left and follow the edge of the ploughed field. The railway is now on the left, with a bridge over it. Don't go over it, but instead carry on and walk towards the wooded area ahead.
- 5) Follow the visible track around the edge of the wood and cut through on the left onto a long straight track. Turn left here. When the track emerges from the trees, turn left and cross the railway using the green footbridge.
- 6) Follow the path off the bridge, and continue to walk down Grove Park Avenue. As the road turns a sharp left,

take the Nidderdale Greenway – National Cycle Network route 67 - signed track on the right, which runs alongside the railway.

- 7) The Greenway emerges into the car park of the Asda supermarket. Head straight across the car park, over the mini roundabout and along the road with the supermarket on your right.
- 8) At the junction with Bower Road, go straight across down Haywra Street. Turn left at the end of Haywra Street onto Bower Street, and then turn right onto East Parade.
- 9) Carry on down East Parade until you meet the roundabout with the Odeon cinema on the left corner. Turn right to cross over the railway once again on Station Bridge, and at the traffic lights, turn right onto Station Parade. Carry on along Station Parade and Harrogate Railway Station's main entrance is on the right.
